



Healthcare in Wyandot County

Wyandot County is served by a wide variety of quality health care professionals providing a broad range of services to its residents.

The centerpiece of the healthcare system in Wyandot County is Wyandot Memorial Hospital. WMH is a locally-owned, non-profit modern medical facility. It is located in Upper Sandusky and is the only hospital in the county. WMH offers a 24-hour emergency department, heliport for emergency transfers, laboratory,



pathology, pharmacy, respiration therapy, radiology, ultrasound, mammography, CT and Dexa scanning, MRI, PET and PET/CT, nuclear medicine, cardiology, physical therapy, JobCare occupational health, Wellness Center rehab and disease prevention programs and durable medical equipment and supplies. Complementing the county's modern medical facilities are private-practice physicians, dentists, physical therapists, audiologists, chiropractors, optometrists, home care providers, hospice care providers and fitness centers, all of whom are dedicated to the health and wellbeing of Wyandot County.

The aging population of Wyandot County is served by two area nursing homes, The Wyandot County Skilled Nursing and Rehabilitation Center and Fairhaven Community. The Inn at Westbrook is an assisted living facility located in Upper Sandusky.
