

## Wyandot County Households

There were over 9,062 households in Wyandot County in 2010 with each household having, on average, 2.49 persons. The average household income was \$47,683 in 2010. Persons below the poverty level were 5.3% of the population in 2010.

The number of housing units in the county in 2010 was 9,729. Home ownership rate in 2010 was 75.8% and the median value of an owner-occupied housing unit was \$105,200. Over 40% of the homes were built before 1940, with many of those in Upper Sandusky on the National Registry of Historic Homes. The median home dates from 1955.

There were 2,196 renter-occupied housing units in Wyandot County in 2010. The median gross rent was \$555.

The predominant source of heating fuel for these housing units was gas, either utility (47%) or bottled (18%).
