



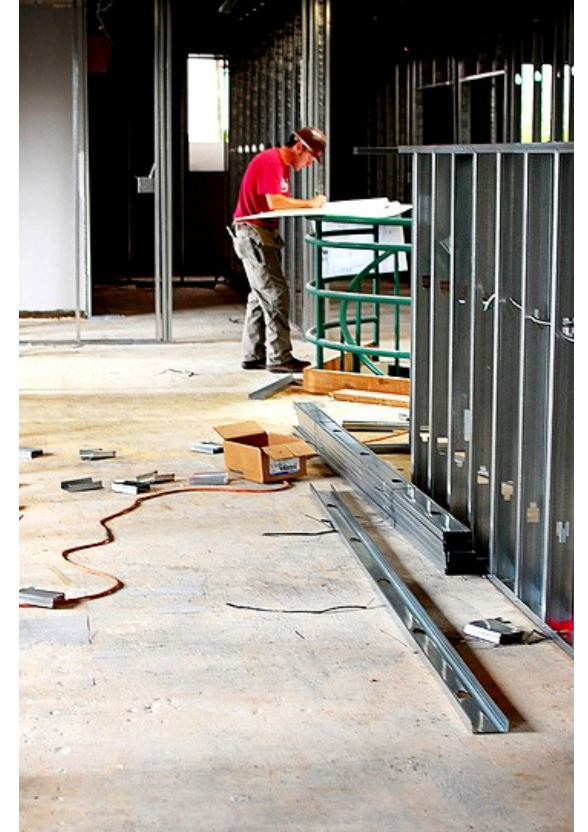

## What We Do

The Wyandot County Office of Economic Development (WCOED) offers a comprehensive Business Retention & Expansion (BR&E) program that is designed to connect local businesses with resources that help to plan and implement growth projects. Through visits and questionnaires, the BR&E program is able to identify areas where local, state, or federal resources may be available to assist local firms in their profitable growth.

- Research & Development Loans
- Community Development Block Grants

Our BR&E Program is designed primarily to assist local businesses, but also serves multiple purposes aiming to enhance the competitiveness of conducting business in the local area.

The BR&E Program serves to:

- Enable community leaders to define the strengths and weaknesses of the local economy as identified by existing businesses and workers
- Use feedback data to develop, prioritize, and implement actionable items and policy that best address local business needs
- Develop a narrative of the local economy
- Create direct lines of communication between policy makers and local industry
