


## Wyandot County Communities

Wyandot County is composed of 13 townships, 1 city, and 7 incorporated villages. The county seat and largest community is Upper Sandusky which is centrally located in the county. Other incorporated villages include Carey, Sycamore, Nevada, Harpster, Wharton, Kirby and Marseilles.

### **City of Upper Sandusky**

The City of Upper Sandusky lies in the center of Wyandot County and serves as the county seat. It is intersected by US Route 30 and US Route 23 as well as State Routes 53, 67 and 199 and has rail service from all directions making it ideal for both families and businesses. Upper Sandusky has a rich history dating back to the 1700's where the Wyandotte Native Americans resided until 1842 and has numerous historical sites to visit. The downtown Upper Sandusky streets are lined with a mix of local, family-owned businesses and retail chains providing a unique shopping experience. Upper Sandusky offers residents a wide variety of restaurants and shopping choices as well as a library, parks, auto dealers and other public services.

### **Village of Carey**

The Village of Carey is the second largest community in Wyandot County. As the largest Wyandot County village, Carey offers residents and business owners a quieter setting while still offering everything a community might need such as groceries, restaurants, salons, hardware, pharmacy, library, parks, automobiles, shopping and more. The new Carey High School for students in kindergarten to grade 12 was a stunning addition to the Village in 2016. Carey is growing rapidly with new industrial operations found in the Arrowhead Commerce Park, and new restaurants, retail, service, and healthcare facilities found in and around the Sheriden Business Park development.

### **Village of Sycamore**

Established in 1842, the Village of Sycamore is abundant with small town values. This small community offers its residents plenty of conveniences without going very far. It features its own community bank, pharmacy, ice cream parlor, gas station, laundromat, pizza parlor, library, grocery store, baseball diamond, swimming pool, park and so much more. Each year the Village of Sycamore hosts a number of community events that bring then entire neighborhood together.
