Wyandot Memorial Hospital

Wyandot Memorial Hospital is a locally owned, non-profit modern full-service medical facility located in Upper Sandusky. It offers a 24-hour emergency department, a heliport for emergency transfers, laboratory services, pharmacy,



physical therapy, occupational health, and many other specialty services. WMH also has a Wellness Center, disease prevention programs as well as medical equipment and supplies.



Carey Medical Center

Carey Medical Center is the primary care provider of choice for patients in the village of Carey and the surrounding region. This office is one of several family medicine locations that are part of the Blanchard Valley Medical Practices division of Blanchard Valley Health System. As a primary care provider, Carey Medical Center offers

preventative care, wellness visits, health screenings, vaccinations, guidance with medication adherence and chronic disease management.
