RE: Public Comments Requested on Proposed Intersection Improvement Project
ODOT Project: WYA-23-18.89 (PID 122805)

Dear neighbor or interested party,

The Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) invites you to share your feedback on proposed improvements to address safety issues at the U.S. 23 and County Highway 4 intersection, northwest of the city of Upper Sandusky. Improvements will also be made at the U.S. 23 and Township Highway 42 intersection, as well as the U.S. 23 and County Highway 103 intersection.

In 2018, ODOT completed a study to identify improvements that could be made to the at-grade intersections along the U.S. 23 corridor to improve the safety of the intersections. ODOT is moving forward with the study recommendation of a Reduced Collision U-Turn (RCUT) at U.S. 23 and County Highway 4. Also, the median pavement and western leg will be removed at U.S. 23 and Township Highway 42. In addition, median pavement removal and cul-de-sac construction on each side will occur at the intersection of U.S. 23 and Township Highway 103.

A preliminary design is shown in the attached exhibit. We are seeking public feedback before advancing the layout into detailed design.

Studies are ongoing to determine the impact the project will have on the environment, utilities, and adjacent properties. It is not expected that right-of-way will be needed for the project.

Construction is expected to be in 2028.
